The Himatlal and Muljibhai Sanghavi Award

\$1,001 prize will be given to applicant with the highest SAT score

The Savitaben and Shantilal Dagli PSAT award

\$501 will be given to the applicant with the highest PSAT score



Eligibility Criteria

- *The Candidate should be a high school student or just graduated*
- *The Candidate is eligible to apply for both awards simultaneously*
- *The parents and the candidate should be members of the IACAW at the time of application
(If you are not a member attach a membership check, and you will be eligible)*
- *Children of the sponsors are not eligible for participation*
- *A candidate or one of the family members should be present at the award presentation ceremony.*

Application must be postmarked by Monday, October 10, 2011

The awards will be presented at the annual Diwali Dinner on Saturday, November 5, 2011. To promote a broader interest, there are no restrictions based upon the residency or financial status or ethnicity.
